

Shine Summer Day Camp Illness and Accident Policies

Child (ren) will not be allowed in our care if he/she:

*Has had a fever within the past 24 hours, or has required the use of a fever reducer for 24 hours.

*Has vomited or had diarrhea within the past 24 hours.

*Has a cough, an eye or ear discharge, or a nasal discharge that is thick, yellow or green.

*Has been treated with an antibiotic less than 24 hours.

*Has a sore throat with pustules on the back of the throat.

*Has a rash.

*Has been diagnosed with a communicable disease.

Parent Notification Plan

If day camp staff observes a change in your child's health, or if your child experiences an accident or injury, or if your child is too ill to remain in the group:

- a) Child will be isolated in a separate area and be cared for until parent arrives;
- b) Parents listed on the Emergency Contact card will be called;
- c) If it is a non-emergency situation, and parents do not respond within 30 minutes, the contact other than parents listed on the Emergency Contact card will be called.
- d) In the event of an emergency, all parents/legal guardians will be called every five minutes until there is a response.
- e) In the event of an emergency, emergency personnel shall be notified prior to the contacting of parents.

Parents will be notified by email if the center becomes aware that a staff member or child in care has contracted a communicable disease. Shine Day Camp will notify parents of both the name and symptoms of the disease.
